Dear Shelburne Shipyard Customer,

The EPA is now requiring us to monitor and report all coatings (varnish, bottom paint, primers, topside paints....) applied to **ALL** boats in our yard. In order to comply with that requirement, we are asking that you let us know about all coatings **you** apply to your boat as soon as possible. If you do not apply any coatings THIS YEAR, then you need not respond.

On the form provided, we will need the **date** you applied the coating as well as the **manufacturer** (Epifanes, Interlux, Petite, etc) of the product. In addition, we need the specific **name** of the coating, the **type** of coating (varnish, bottom paint, etc) and the **quantity** applied. When you have the form completed, please turn it in to the office. At that point we will calculate the required totals of VOCs (Volatile Organic Compounds) and HAPs (Hazardous Airborne Pollutants) which the EPA requires of us.

This process will keep all of us compliant with current EPA requirements. We truly appreciate your assistance with this. If you need additional forms, just stop at the office and we'll be happy to provide them to you.
